WHO MAY ENTER: Adult and Youth exhibitors age 12 and over.

ENTRY BLANKS: See general rules.

ENTRY TAGS: Must be securely fastened to exhibit. See general rules.

DELIVER EXHIBIT: To North section Main Exhibit Building, Thursday from 6 to 9 PM. **No entries will be accepted on Friday.**

ENTRY FEES: Exhibitors must include \$7.00 entry fee which entitles them to enter other areas of the Fair and provides for admission to the Fair all three days.

1. All exhibits must remain in place until 5:30 P. M. Sunday.
2. Any exhibit using material on the State Conservation list as published by the Federal Garden Clubs of CT, Inc. will be disqualified.
3. Exhibitors must furnish their own container. Please No paper, styrofoam or plastic cups
4. Exhibitors are allowed only one entry in each class.
5. Judging in specimen classes is based on the quality of the specimens rather than the quantity. (classes 1 through 79)
6. Judging of flowers is mainly on uniformity of size; development, height, and color. Other important factors are freedom from insect and/or disease damage and growth characteristics of variety displayed and finally showmanship.
7. No store bought flowers allowed.
