DELIVER EXHIBIT: To the Main Exhibit Building, **Thursday from 6 to 9 P.m.** No exhibits will be accepted on Friday.

ENTRY FEES: Adult Exhibitors must include \$7.00 entry fee which entitles them to enter other areas of the Fair and provides for admission to the Fair on all three days.

Overall Appearance; 40%; Crust, 10%; Flavor, 40%; Texture, 10%

1. A 9” Two Crusted Pie
2. Submit a 3x5 card with recipe and your name and address printed clearly.
3. No pre-made crust or mix will be allowed. No lattice crust
4. The main ingredient must be apples, however pies may include other fruits or ingredients.
5. Please use a non-returnable baking dish.

STATE CONTEST: The State Apple Pie Contest will be held at the the 2009 Association of Connecticut Fairs fall meeting. The winner of the Bethlehem contest will be notified by the Fair Secretary as to the exact date, place and time.
