The Bethlehem Fair welcomes your display to be housed in our photo and craft building. Tables will be assigned by a drawing. Assigned numbers will be posted in the Grange section.

1. Ten front feet of exhibit space, approximately three feet in width, will be allowed for each Grange for their display. The length of the background can be from four feet to the full ten feet that the exhibit allows. Cage is not provided. Displays may be arranged **Thursday, between 1:00 pm and 9:00 pm, or Friday, after 1:00 pm. Display must be in place before 5:00 pm on Friday.**
2. At least ten members of each Subordinate Grange must contribute time or materials to the display. Each competing Grange shall present, in their display, a Grange theme of **“If the roots are good so are the branches”** and judging will be based on the interpretation pertaining to attracting new members. Points will be awarded on: theme and manner of presentation (40 points), originality (20 points), quality (20 points), and appearance (20 points).
3. Grange name **must not** appear on the display. After judging, the committee will place name cards in each display. No content list is required because judging will be based on originality and knowledge of the Grange purpose. Do not use Grange implements or photos of Granges in your display. The judges will be Grange members.
4. Committees planning to use crepe paper are warned that this must be flameproof to meet fire inspection.
5. The right of sale to the public of items included in the display will be given each Grange, but items sold must not be removed prior to **5:30 pm on Sunday.**
6. Five guest tickets will be provided to the committee of each Grange entering a display.
