**PARKING:** Parking behind the Poultry & Rabbit Building will be limited to vehicles carrying large animals. All vehicles must be relocated to the general parking area after dropping off exhibits. Entry will be available Sunday afternoon after 5:30 pm to pick up exhibits. Exhibitor passes will be issued upon arrival with animals.

**WHO MAY ENTER:** Adults and juniors under age 12. Connecticut residents will be given priority.

**ENTRY BLANKS:** Must be sent to: Susan Kline, 46 Bannon Street, Torrington, CT 06790. Telephone 860-482-8051. Entries close on the Wednesday before Labor Day or when cages are full. **No** telephone entries will be accepted after this day either, to allow for delegating of cage space.

**EXHIBITOR TAGS:** Will be attached to cages by committee.

**DELIVER EXHIBIT:** To Rabbit and Poultry Barn Thursday, 5 pm to 9 pm. Enter through the South gate. Animals must remain until **5:30 PM Sunday**. No exceptions.

**EXHIBIT REMOVAL:** See **General Rules, Livestock Exhibitors, page 9.**

**ENTRY FEES:** ADULTS: \$9.00 for first three animals, each additional animal \$.50. JUNIORS under 12 years of age: \$.50 each animal.

## Department Rules

1. Cavies are Guinea Pigs.
2. This is an American Rabbit Breeders Association sanctioned show, but pet stock will be accepted. ARBA Rules Applied.
3. **All** animals entered in the show must have a permanent tattoo or tag beginning in 2004. The number **must** be listed on the entry blank. Only 4 pet class rabbits and or cavies per exhibitor. **Pets limited to youth under 18 years old.**
4. Feed will be provided by the fair. **Only** committee members are to feed, water, and bed the animals, during the fair. **No Animals are to be out of their cages for any reason, after judging.**
5. Judging will start at 4:00 pm on Friday **or at the convenience of the judge.**
6. Sick or diseased animals will not be admitted and will be removed from cages if noticed after admission, or disqualified if found to be diseased by the judge.
7. Only the committee will be allowed behind the judges table while animals are being judged. **NO ONE** is to interfere with the judging.
8. No breeding will be permitted at the show.
9. No advertising will be permitted until after judging. At that time neat cards may be placed on the cages.
10. No animals are to be sold unless they are entered in the show. Sold animals **MUST** remain until 5:30 pm Sunday.
11. **NO SALES** to children without **DIRECT** parental permission.
12. Exhibitor passes will be handed out for all entries received.
13. **Each Animal MUST HAVE TWO proper sized heavy plastic or ceramic bowls. No bottles or 2 sided bowls. NO EXCEPTIONS. Bowls may be RENTED from the committee if needed.**

14. Vicious animals' cages **must** be marked by owner.

15. ARBA Rules state No child under 5 yrs old can show in Breed Show, only Pets Class.
